

# OPERATING & SAFETY GUIDE

## STEAM IRON

### GENERAL SAFETY

Contact us for information and advice on the suitability and safety of this type of equipment. There is a risk of injury if you do not follow the instructions printed in this guide.

This equipment should only be used by a competent adult who has read and understood these instructions. Anyone with a temporary or permanent disability should seek expert advice before using the equipment.

Keep all children, animals and bystanders away from the work area. Ensure the floor of the work area is free from trip hazards and non-slip. Never use the equipment if you are ill, tired or under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

Never operate electrical switches with wet hands. Always switch off and unplug the equipment from the power supply before moving or cleaning.

Check the equipment before use, if it shows signs of damage request a replacement.

### ELECTRICAL SAFETY

The equipment is designed to plug directly into a standard 240volt, 13 amp socket. Make sure the equipment and power socket are switched off before plugging into the power supply.

If the equipment fails to operate or the power cable or plug becomes damaged, contact us. Do not try to repair it yourself.

Keep the power cable out of harm's way. Extension leads should be unwound fully, never run them through water, over sharp objects or where they may be a trip hazard.

Use a suitable RCD (Residual Current Operated Device) to reduce the risk of electric shock.

Ensure the steam iron and power socket are switched off before plugging in.

The steam iron should be positioned to give easy access to the user yet sufficiently out of the way to reduce the risk of it being touched or knocked.

You must have water in the tank and the steam control set to "steam" for steam functions to work.

Empty any remaining water after each use to prevent mineral buildup.

Use the spray and steam boost for stubborn creases.

### OPERATING GUIDE cont'd

**Fill:** Open the clip, fill the 350ml tank with water (max fill line), and close.

**Power On:** Place the iron on its heel, plug it in, and the red power light comes on.

**Set Temp:** Turn the dial to your fabric type (e.g., Linen, Cotton, Synthetic).

**Heat Up:** The power light will cycle on/off as it heats; it's ready when the light goes out.

**Steam/Spray:**  
Slide the steam control to the desired steam level (or 'no steam').  
Press the steam boost trigger for a powerful burst (210g).  
Press the spray button to moisten fabric for tough creases.

### EQUIPMENT CARE & CLEANING

Fill the tank, plug in, and let it heat (light off).

Hold the iron horizontally over a sink.

Press and hold the self-clean button to flush out mineral deposits and scale.
